Other local EMCOMM nets that are called during the week:

On Tuesday nights at 1900hrs, the Dinwiddie County ARES Net meets on the 147.390 repeater, with a PL of 74.4hz.

On Tuesday nights at 2000hrs, the Powhatan ARES Net meets on the 147.315 repeater, with a PL of 74.4hz, with the exception of the third Tuesday of month which is when they hold their monthly meeting.

On Wednesday nights at 2000hrs, the Tri-Cities EMCOMM Net meets on the 147.390.

Also on Wednesday nights at 2000hrs, the South Central ARES net meets on the 147.000, with a PL of 77.0hz.

On Thursday nights at 1900hrs, the Virginia District 1 ARES Net meets alternating on the 145.430 and 146.880 repeaters, both of which have a PL of 74.4hz.
